

# Dumas Leaps 6-10 for Tie With Shelton

## Centennial Prep Steals Show in Fresno Spikefest

FRESNO, May 14 — Charles Dumas, a Centennial High School boy, came within a skinny whisker of upsetting Ernie Shelton in the high jump tonight at the 29th annual West Coast Relays.

Dumas cleared 6ft. 10in., by two inches the greatest leap ever made by a prep.

He did it on his first try—cleanly. And Shelton failed on his first two.

Then the Trojan leaper, unbeaten in the past two years but facing a stunning defeat here, scraped over the bar on his final try, the bar wobbling for a few seconds but staying on the uprights.

### Set Meet Mark

Their joint efforts, the event officially ending in the tie at 6-10, set a new meet record, bettering Shelton's record of 6-9 $\frac{1}{2}$  of a year ago.

This afternoon Dumas qualified in a sectional CIF meet at Paramount High, then flew here for tonight's meet. A week ago he jumped 6ft. 8in. for a national prep record but tonight's effort will not count as a high school mark since it was not made in an all-prep meet.

Both jumpers tried 6ft. 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ in. But failed.

### Broke Meet Mark

Max Truex, SC's little freshman distance whiz, broke a meet record in the first event concluded during the evening program at which 14,000 fans were in attendance.

The crowd in the afternoon when Wes Santee stepped his 4:08.5 mile was estimated at 12,000.

Truex won the 5000-meter run in 14:57.5, nearly 5 seconds under Art Garcia's West Coast Relays record, as he held an even pace through the long grind.

Rafer Johnson, UCLA's frosh all-round star, tied a national yearling hurdle mark of 14 flat in the prelims, but did no better than second in the finals, won by Will Wright of LAAC in 14.2. Johnson was two yards back in the finals.

### Slight Wind

A 3.5 m.p.h. wind aided the hurdlers, below the allowable windage for record acceptance.

Mike Agostini, Fresno State's ineligible transfer student who was the British Empire 100-meter champ from Trinidad, captured a swift

and thrilling 100-yard finals by inches in 9.4. The aiding breeze was 3.3.

The Trojans were close in the 440, won by Oxy. They dropped the baton (Pat Coyle handing to John Morgan) in the 680, won by Stanford. They were only fourth in the two mile, won by LAAC. And in the four-man mile starting just before the stroke of midnight, the Trojans were fourth as Stanford scored a surprisingly easy college victory.

None of the times approached meet record standards, but Bud Held, the Olympic Club's world record holder in the javelin, pitched the spear 262ft. 2 1/4 in.; believed to be the second best in history and barely short of his 263-10 world standard.

Team honors were divided after nearly 12 hours of competition between Los Angeles Athletic Club and Southern California. In the Open Division scoring the Clubmen scored 45 1/2 points to 44 for the Trojans. In collegiate tabulations the Trojans had 61 points to 58 4-5 for Stanford, 57 1/2 for Occidental and 57 1-5 for UCLA.
