

Smith '96 Anchors San Jose to 880 Record: 1.22.1

FRESNO—Running almost alone, Tommie Smith hit a 120-yard sprint in 19.6 seconds to anchor San Jose State to a 1:22.1 world record in the 800-meter relay here Saturday night.

Forty minutes later the second leg of Smith, Lee Evans, Ken Shackelford and Bob Talmadge came back to run the second 400-meter leg of all-time, 3:03.3, and establish an American record in the relay here Saturday night.

The 30th world record set or tied in the West Coast Relays, which were run for the first time Saturday under perfect weather conditions.

It was a typical Smith record performance. Tommie doesn't just set records, he obligates them. In the 1:22.1 lowered the 880 record by a full half-second from the 1:22.6 made by the late American anchor by the great Bobby Morrow, in 1938.

Plenty of Help

Smith had plenty of help, particularly from an underheralded sophomore, Bob Talmadge, who attended Hoopa Valley High in the tiny hamlet of Willow Creek, Talmadge, a run-of-the-mill 230-440 man until Saturday, ran the second leg in 20.1 to put the Spartans far in front as he led the national set of AAU 400-yard champion Lee Evans, who breezed through his first 220 out of the blocks, started things off with a 21.1 furling.

In the final, Evans was even swifter than Smith, running 44.6 to give Tommie the big lead over UCLA's Don Domansky. Smith ran 45.0 with Talmadge rickrolling 47.5 and Shackelford 48.4.

Only the Trinidad and Tobago national team, anchored by Wendell Motley, ran faster in the Spartans' 3:03.3. They ran 3:02.8 last August.

Boston Sharp

Before the Spartan outburst, the meet had seen such world best performances of the year as a 27-2.64 long jump by Ralph Boston and a 20.1 intermediate hurdles by Ron Whittney.

Boston's record, coming on his second jump, unnerved young Bob Beamon, who beat Boston at

the Mt. San Antonio Relays. Beamon, 19-year-old National AAU indoor champion, fouled on all three jumps.

Although odd-timer Jay Silverst won the discus at a meet record 205-292, the disappointing starter was USC's Gary Carlson, whose second-place effort of 203.1 gave him a school record. Gary, who broke the 13th discus thrower in the world (and the 10th in the U.S.) last year, broke Erik Babka's USC mark of 198-10 made in 1958.

Back in third place for one of the longest finishes of his long career, which includes three Olympic gold medals, was Al Oerter. At that, Oerter surpassed his own year-old meet mark of 193.0.

George Pure, the Latvian-born Canadian, finished second in the 107.8-2 throwing for the U. of Nevada. Friday night, dedicating for 107-8-2, he proved not to compete with the big boys Saturday.

Another best in the world in his career was posted by Tracy Smith, the former Acadia High miler, with an 8:32.5 two mile. Tracy led all the way to hold off George Scott of New Mexico and Australis, who clocked 8:34.5.

Copeland Wins High

Ron Copeland, after getting his hand spiked while running a brilliant 13.6 high hurdle relay, came back to nip Ervin Hall of Villanova in a 1:18 final. Copeland, off slowly, never fell until the final inches.

Copeland's chief rival, USC's Earl McCulloch, was one of several Trojans who suffered from nerves and/or a lack of focus. McCulloch got stopped in the middle of his hurdle heat, while intermediate hurdler George Tomaras, who beat Ervin, Ron Miller and javelin thrower John Fitzsimons did not compete.

Pierce, coached by former Olympic half-mile Bob Chambers, kept the relay's momentum on a national JC record by running the two mile in 7:29.3 —over three seconds under Stan Anis record.
