

Amassing a total of 79 points, Rhode Island State College inaugurated the Yankee Conference track competition here today sweeping to eight first places, six of which came in the running races.

The Rams kept the remaining four teams out of the running throughout the day. In second place with 43½ points was host team, University of New Hampshire. Third place went to the University of Maine, which captured 23½ points, and the fourth position was held by Connecticut with 19 points.

Leading the scorers was New Hampshire's Frank Barndollar who won the 100 and 220 yard dashes and grabbed a third in the 220 yard low hurdles. Bob Dahl of Rhode Island won both the low and high hurdles to give the Rams 10 points. Dick Lopes, brought the Wildcats 10 points with his victories in the discus and the broad jump.
