

DURHAM, N.H. (AP) — The University of New Hampshire reigned for the first time today as the Yankee Conference track champion.

The Wildcats scored in 15 of 17 events to pile up $68\frac{3}{4}$ points Saturday as host to the 29th annual meet. Rhode Island was second with $63\frac{1}{4}$ points, followed by defending champion Massachusetts with 61, Maine 45, Connecticut $29\frac{1}{4}$ and Vermont 4.
