

KINGSTON, R.I. — The University of Massachusetts won its second straight Yankee Conference Track and Field championship Saturday in an eight-team meet which produced four new conference records.

The Redmen piled up 73½ points to beat runner-up Rhode Island (57) and third place finisher Connecticut (50½).

Record breaking performances included: Danny Weed of Rhode Island with a leap of 46 feet, 11 and three-quarter inches in the triple jump; Paul Ianetta of Rhody with a throw of 239 feet, four inches in the javelin; Paul Metallo of UMass with a 9.4 second clocking in the 100-yard dash; and the Connecticut mile relay team of Rich Fetzer, Steve Hulme, Jim Verdon and Jay Sher with a time of three minutes, 19.6 seconds.

UConn's decathlon star Ron Evans captured the high jump with a leap of six feet, seven and three quarter inches and took fifth place in both the discus and pole vault. Billy Parkton of Connecticut took a second in the 220 and third in the 100-yard dash and sophomore Brian Bassaline established a new

UConn mark in the 440-yard intermediate hurdles by winning in the time 54.4 seconds.
