

ORONO, Me.—Rhode Island built up a substantial lead in the field events and swept to an upset win in the Yankee Conferences Track and Field Championship at the University of Maine Field House Saturday.

Rhode Island compiled 49½ points to outdistance surprise up Maine by more than eight points. Defending champion and pre-meet favorite Massachusetts finished with 40 points a point out of second place.

Robert Narcessian and his brother Dick finished 1-2 in the 35-lb. weight to give Rhode Island an early lead. Narcessian's winning throw of 64 ft., 3 in. broke both a Yankee Conference and Maine Field House record.

Rhode Island also won the pole vault, took a first and fourth in the shot put, a second and fifth in the long jump and tied for third in the high jump.

Rhode Island's Charlie McGinness set a Yankee Conference record in the 1000 with a time of 2:12.7, and Maine's mile winning relay team snapped two seconds off the old Yankee Conference mark with a time of 3:24.5.
